2. Description of the product

- Intended use: Decorative natural items for floristry, handicrafts, seasonal decorations and arrangements.
- Material composition:
 - O Materials: Natural materials such as cones, wood, bark, moss, twigs, leaves, dried flowers, seaweed and coconut fibers.
 - O Surfaces: Natural, dried, colored, varnished or coated.
 - O Additives: colors, glitter, glue, ribbons or metal elements.

3. Possible dangers

- Fire hazard: Natural materials such as wood, moss, dried flowers and bark are highly flammable.
- Danger of cutting or stabbing: Sharp edges or pointed branches and fibers can cause injuries.
- Dust development: Dry natural materials can release dust that can irritate the respiratory tract.
- Allergic reactions: Pollen, fibers or dust can cause allergic reactions in sensitive people.
- Danger of mold: Natural materials can become moldy when they come into contact with moisture.

4. Safety instructions

4.1 General safety instructions

- Keep away from children and pets, especially small parts that could be swallowed.
- Keep away from open flames and sources of ignition.
- Avoid dust formation and use in well-ventilated areas.
