

## 1. Product and company identification

## 2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** LED candles for indoor and outdoor use for decoration and lighting.
  - **Material composition:**
    - **Housing:** plastic or real wax.
    - **Light source:** LED (light-emitting diode).
    - **Power supply:** batteries (e.g. AA, AAA) or rechargeable batteries.
    - **Additions:** Timer function if necessary, flame effect.

## 3. Possible dangers

- **Electrical hazards:** If batteries are handled improperly, there is a risk of short circuits or leakage.
  - **Fire hazard:** Low, but be careful when using LED candles with real wax coating near open flames.
  - **Health hazards:** None when used properly.

## 4. Safety instructions

### 4.1 General safety instructions

- **Be careful when handling batteries!**
- **Do not immerse in water or expose to extreme heat.**

### 4.2 Notes on use

1. Only operate LED candles with the recommended battery types.
2. Insert batteries according to the polarity indication.
3. If not in use for a long time, remove batteries to prevent leakage.
4. Do not place LED candles with real wax coating near open flames or heat sources.
5. Do not use defective or damaged LED candles.

### 4.3 Notes for multiple LED candles

- When using multiple LED candles, ensure adequate ventilation to avoid overheating.

### 4.4 Further warnings

- LED candles are not suitable for use in damp rooms unless they are specifically marked for this purpose.
  - If there is visible damage to the LED candle or battery compartments, stop using it immediately.

## 5. First aid measures

- **If leaking batteries come into contact with skin:** Rinse the affected area with plenty of water and seek medical advice if irritation occurs.
  - **If batteries are swallowed:** Get medical attention immediately.
  - **If battery solution comes into contact with eyes:** Flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes and seek medical attention immediately.

## 6. Measures in case of accidental release

- **If batteries leak:** Wear protective gloves, absorb spilled liquid with a dry cloth and clean affected areas thoroughly.

## 7. Handling and storage

- **Handling:**
    - Handle LED candles carefully to avoid damage.
    - Do not mix batteries (old and new or different types).
  - **Storage:**
    - Store in a cool, dry place.
    - Protect from direct sunlight and high temperatures.
    - Store batteries separately from metal objects to avoid short circuits.
