

1. Product and company identification

2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** Candles and scented candles for indoor use for room fragrance and decoration.
- **Material composition:**
 - **Wax:** paraffin, stearin, beeswax or vegetable waxes.
 - **Wick:** cotton or synthetic materials.
 - **Additives:** fragrances, essential oils, dyes.

3. Possible dangers

- **Main hazard:** Risk of fire if handled improperly.
- **Health hazards:** Possible allergic reactions due to fragrances contained.
- **Danger from hot wax:** risk of burns if touched.
- **Environmental hazards:** Some fragrances may be harmful to aquatic organisms.

4. Safety instructions

4.1 General safety instructions

- **Be careful when using open fire!**
- **Use only in a stable, upright position.**
- **Keep away from flammable materials.**

4.2 Notes on use

1. Never leave candles burning unattended.
2. Keep out of reach of children and pets.
3. Place only on heat-resistant, non-flammable surfaces.
4. Do not use in drafts or near fans.
5. Ventilate the room after use to avoid the accumulation of fragrances.

4.3 Notes for multiple candles

- Keep a distance of at least 10 cm between burning candles.

4.4 Further warnings

- Before lighting, shorten the wick to approx. 1 cm.
- Extinguish the candle before it has completely burned down (approx. 1 cm of remaining wax).
- Do not move hot, liquid wax.
- Do not leave any foreign objects such as matches or wick remnants in the liquid wax mass.
- If smoke develops or the flame becomes excessive, extinguish the candle and trim the wick.

5. First aid measures

- **If hot wax comes into contact with skin:** cool with cold water, do not remove wax, seek medical attention.
- **If smoke or fragrances are inhaled:** provide fresh air; if symptoms persist, seek medical advice.
- **If allergic reactions occur:** discontinue use and seek medical advice if necessary.

6. Firefighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing agents:** CO₂, foam, powder.
- **Unsuitable extinguishing media:** Water (for wax fires).
- **Special protective measures:** Provide fire extinguishers; do not extinguish burning candles with water.

7. Storage and transport

- **Storage:**
 - Store in a dry, cool place protected from direct sunlight.
 - Avoid contact with flammable materials.
- **Transport:**
 - Protect from damage and extreme temperatures.
 - Labeling of dangerous goods.

8. Disposal instructions

- Dispose of wax residues in the household waste unless special regulations apply.
- Recycle packaging materials according to local regulations.
