2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** Plastic planters for planting and decoration indoors and outdoors.
- **Material composition:**
 - **Materials:** Various types of plastic (e.g. polypropylene, polyethylene, PVC).

3. Possible dangers

4.3 Storage instructions

- Protect plastic containers from direct sunlight unless UV stabilised.

5. First aid measures

- **In case of cuts caused by sharp edges:** Clean and disinfect the wound and seek medical attention if necessary.
- **If skin irritation occurs due to material abrasion:** Clean thoroughly with soap and water.
- **In case of eye injury caused by falling objects:** Get medical advice immediately.

6. Firefighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing agents:** CO₂, foam, powder.
- **Special measures:** Plastic parts can release toxic fumes in case of fire – wear respiratory protection.
- **Note:** Plastic planters are flammable and should not be placed near open flames.

7. Storage and transport

- **Storage:**
 - Stack planters securely to avoid deformation or damage.
 - Protect plastic parts from moisture and extreme temperatures.
- **Transport:**
 - Pack products securely to avoid breakage or scratches.

8. Disposal instructions

- **Material-dependent disposal:**
 - Plastic parts: Recycling according to local regulations.
 - Damaged or unusable containers: residual waste.
- Recycle packaging materials according to local regulations.
