2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** Decorative natural items for floristry, handicrafts, seasonal decorations and arrangements.
- **Material composition:**
 - **Materials:** Natural materials such as cones, wood, bark, moss, twigs, leaves, dried flowers, seaweed and coconut fibers.
 - **Surfaces:** Natural, dried, colored, varnished or coated.
 - **Additives:** colors, glitter, glue, ribbons or metal elements.

3. Possible dangers

- **Fire hazard:** Natural materials such as wood, moss, dried flowers and bark are highly flammable.
- **Danger of cutting or stabbing:** Sharp edges or pointed branches and fibers can cause injuries.
- **Dust development:** Dry natural materials can release dust that can irritate the respiratory tract.
- **Allergic reactions:** Pollen, fibers or dust can cause allergic reactions in sensitive people.
- **Danger of mold:** Natural materials can become moldy when they come into contact with moisture.

4. Safety instructions

4.1 General safety instructions

- **Keep away from children and pets, especially small parts that could be swallowed.**
- **Keep away from open flames and sources of ignition.**
- **Avoid dust formation and use in well-ventilated areas.**
- **If you have known allergies, take protective measures (e.g. respiratory protection).**

4.2 Notes on use

1. Use natural items only for their intended decorative purpose.
2. Avoid moisture to prevent mold growth.
3. When working with sharp or pointed natural materials (e.g. branches), work carefully and wear gloves.
4. Protect decorative items from direct sunlight to minimize color changes.
5. Clean products regularly to avoid dust accumulation.

4.3 Storage instructions

- Store in a dry, cool place protected from light.
- Protect from moisture to avoid material deterioration or mold growth.
- Pack fragile items such as dried flowers in a shock-protected manner.

5. First aid measures

- **In case of cuts or puncture wounds:** Clean and disinfect the wound and seek medical attention if necessary.
- **If dust is inhaled:** ensure fresh air supply and seek medical advice if symptoms persist.
- **If skin irritation occurs:** Clean affected areas thoroughly with soap and water.
- **If allergic reactions occur:** discontinue use and seek medical advice.
- **If small parts are swallowed:** seek medical attention immediately.

6. Firefighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing agents:** water, CO₂, foam or powder.
- **Special measures:** Wear respiratory protection as burning natural materials can produce smoke and toxic fumes.

7. Storage and transport

- **Storage:**
 - Store in a dry place and protected from moisture.
 - Stack fragile items carefully or pack them securely.
- **Transport:**
 - Protect natural items from mechanical damage.
 - Transport products dry and dust-free.

8. Disposal instructions

- **Material-dependent disposal:**
 - Natural materials such as wood, moss or dried flowers: composting or residual waste.
 - Colored or coated materials: Dispose of in residual waste according to local regulations.
 - Packaging materials: Recycle or dispose of according to local regulations.
