2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** Decorative items for weddings, including table decorations, pendants, figurines, arrangements, candles, vases and floristic materials.
- **Material composition:**
 - **Materials:** wood, plastic, ceramics, glass, metal, textiles, paper or natural materials.
 - **Surfaces:** Painted, coated, printed, mirrored, decorated or glittered.
 - **Additives:** paints, adhesives, coatings, artificial flowers, bows, ribbons, feathers or beads.

3. Possible dangers

- **Fire hazard:** Easily flammable materials such as textiles, paper, wood or coated decorations.
- **Choking hazard:** Small elements such as beads, ribbons or decorative pieces can be swallowed by children or pets.
- **Cuts:** Sharp edges on glass, metal or ceramic can cause injuries.
- **Dust development:** Dried flowers, glitter or natural materials can release dust that can irritate the respiratory tract.
- **Chemical exposure:** Paints, adhesives and coatings can cause irritation if they come into contact with the skin or are inhaled.

4. Safety instructions

4.1 General safety instructions

- **Keep away from children and pets, especially small parts that could be swallowed.**
- **Keep away from open flames, heat sources and sources of ignition.**
- **Avoid dust formation and use in well-ventilated areas.**
- **Wear protective gloves if skin irritation is known.**

4.2 Notes on use

1. Use wedding decorations only for their intended decorative purpose.
2. Never leave candles burning unattended and place them on heat-resistant surfaces.
3. Handle fragile materials such as glass and ceramics with care.
4. Remove glitter and dust particles regularly to avoid contamination.
5. Do not attach heavy or sharp objects insecurely.

4.3 Storage instructions

- Store in a dry, cool place protected from light.
- Pack fragile items securely and store them in a shock-protected manner.
- Keep away from moisture, direct sunlight and fire sources.

5. First aid measures

- **In case of cuts:** Clean and disinfect the wound and seek medical attention if necessary.
- **If skin irritation occurs:** Clean thoroughly with soap and water.
- **If eye irritation occurs due to dust or glitter:** Rinse eye carefully with clean water and seek medical advice.
- **If small parts are swallowed:** seek medical attention immediately.
- **If dust is inhaled:** ensure fresh air supply and seek medical advice if symptoms occur.

6. Firefighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing media:** CO₂, foam, powder, water.
- **Special measures:** Wear respiratory protection as toxic fumes may be produced when coated or decorative materials are burned.

7. Storage and transport

- **Storage:**
 - Store in a cool, dry and dust-free place.
 - Pack fragile materials safely.
- **Transport:**
 - Stack products safely and protect them from impacts and moisture.

8. Disposal instructions

- **Material-dependent disposal:**
 - Wood, paper and natural materials: composting or residual waste.
 - Plastic parts: Recycling according to local regulations.
 - Glass or ceramic elements: old glass or residual waste.
 - Coated or combined materials: Dispose of via residual waste.
- Recycle packaging materials according to local regulations.
