2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** Decorative ribbons and gift ribbon for packaging and handicrafts.
- **Material composition:**
 - **Materials:** textiles (e.g. polyester, cotton), plastic, paper or metal threads.

4.2 Notes on use

1. Handle tapes carefully to avoid cuts or injuries.
2. Do not put toxic coatings or varnishes in mouth.
3. Use only for intended decorative purposes.

4.3 Storage instructions

- Store in a dry place, protected from direct sunlight.
- Avoid contact with water to prevent discoloration or material damage.

5. First aid measures

- **If skin irritation occurs due to coatings:** Clean skin thoroughly with soap and water.
- **If dust or particles are inhaled:** ensure fresh air supply; seek medical advice if symptoms occur.
- **If swallowed:** Do not induce vomiting and seek medical attention immediately.

6. Firefighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing agents:** CO₂, foam, powder.
- **Unsuitable extinguishing media:** Water (may not be suitable for certain materials).
- **Special protective measures:** Wear respiratory protection in case of fire gases.

7. Storage and transport

- **Storage:**
 - Keep cool, dry and protect from mechanical damage.
- **Transport:**
 - Protect from moisture and extreme heat.

8. Disposal instructions

- **Dispose of depending on the material:**
 - Plastic straps: Recycling according to local regulations.
 - Paper-based tapes: waste paper collection.
 - Coated or metallized tapes: residual waste.
- Recycle packaging according to local regulations.
