

## 1. Product and company identification

- **Product name:** LED grave light with timer cemetery candle for battery red H12.5cm

## 2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** Grave candles for outdoor use, especially for coping with grief and in remembrance of deceased pets.
  - **Material composition:**
    - **Wax:** paraffin or stearin.
    - **Wick:** cotton or synthetic materials.
    - **Housing:** glass or plastic with decorative elements.
    - **Lid:** metal, often gold colored.
    - **Additives:** dyes or fragrances if necessary.

## 3. Possible dangers

- **Main hazard:** Risk of fire if handled improperly.
  - **Danger from hot wax:** risk of burns if touched.
  - **Health hazards:** None when used properly.
  - **Environmental hazards:** Improper disposal may cause environmental pollution.

## 4. Safety instructions

### 4.1 General safety instructions

- **Be careful when using open fire!**
- **Use only in a stable, upright position.**
- **Keep away from flammable materials.**

### 4.2 Notes on use

1. Never leave grave candles burning unattended.
2. Keep out of reach of children and pets.
3. Place only on heat-resistant, non-flammable surfaces.
4. Do not use near flammable materials.
5. In case of strong wind or rain, extinguish the candle to avoid danger.

### 4.3 Notes for multiple candles

- Keep a distance of at least 10 cm between burning candles.

### 4.4 Further warnings

- Before lighting, shorten the wick to approx. 1 cm.
  - Extinguish the candle before it has completely burned down (approx. 1 cm of remaining wax).
  - Do not move hot, liquid wax.
  - Do not leave any foreign objects such as matches or wick remnants in the liquid wax mass.
  - If smoke develops or the flame becomes excessive, extinguish the candle and trim the wick.

## 5. First aid measures

- **If hot wax comes into contact with skin:** cool with cold water, do not remove wax, seek medical attention.
  - **If smoke is inhaled:** provide fresh air; if symptoms persist, seek medical advice.
  - **In case of burns:** cool immediately and seek medical attention.
- 

## 6. Firefighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing agents:** CO<sub>2</sub>, foam, powder.
  - **Unsuitable extinguishing media:** Water (for wax fires).
  - **Special protective measures:** Provide fire extinguishers; do not extinguish burning candles with water.
- 

## 7. Handling and storage

- **Handling:**
    - Handle candles carefully to avoid damage.
    - Do not tilt or shake the candle when it is burning or the wax is liquid.
  - **Storage:**
    - Store in a cool, dry place.
    - Protect from direct sunlight and high temperatures.
    - Keep away from flammable materials.
- 

## 8. Disposal instructions

- **Candle remains:** Dispose of in household waste unless special regulations apply.
  - **Housing (glass or plastic):** Dispose of according to local recycling regulations.
