2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** Anniversary numbers for decoration for celebrations, anniversaries or festive occasions.
 - **Material composition:**

3. Possible dangers

- **Risk of mechanical injury:** Sharp edges or pointed fasteners can cause injuries.
 - **Choking hazard:** Small or broken parts can be swallowed by children or pets.
 - **Fire hazard:** Easily flammable surfaces such as glitter or varnish.
 - **Chemical exposure:** Paints, coatings or adhesives can be harmful if they come into direct contact with the skin or are inhaled.

4. Safety instructions

4.1 General safety instructions

- **Keep away from children and pets, especially small parts or sharp elements.**
- **Keep away from open flames and heat sources.**
- **Not suitable for consumption - purely decorative purpose.**

4.2 Notes on use

1. Handle anniversary figures carefully to avoid injuries and breakages.
2. If damaged, do not continue to use to avoid the risk of splintering or breakage.
3. Securely fasten products to prevent them from tipping over or falling.
4. Avoid direct skin contact with glitter or colors if allergic reactions are known.

4.3 Storage instructions

- Store in a cool, dry and dust-free place.
 - Protect from direct sunlight to prevent discoloration or material damage.
 - Store fragile items safely to avoid breakage.

5. First aid measures

- **In case of cuts caused by sharp edges:** Clean and disinfect the wound and seek medical attention if necessary.
 - **If skin irritation occurs due to coatings or glitter:** Clean skin thoroughly with soap and water.
 - **If parts are swallowed:** Get medical attention immediately.
 - **If glitter or particles cause eye irritation:** Rinse with clean water and seek medical advice.

6. Firefighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing agents:** CO₂, foam, powder.
 - **Special measures:** Wear respiratory protection when handling burning coatings or glitter.
 - **Note:** Combustible materials can release toxic fumes.

7. Storage and transport

- **Storage:**
 - Store in a cool, dry and safe place.
 - Protect from mechanical damage.
 - **Transport:**
 - Pack products securely to prevent breakage or loss of small parts.
 - Protect from strong shocks and pressure.

8. Disposal instructions

- **Material-dependent disposal:**
 - Plastic: Recycling according to local regulations.
 - Metal parts: Dispose of via metal waste.
 - Coated materials: residual waste.
 - Recycle packaging materials according to local regulations.
