2. Description of the product

- **Intended use:** Supplies for floristry supplies, decoration, craft projects and packaging applications.
- **Material composition:**
 - **Materials:** plastic, metal, paper, textiles or combined materials.
 - **Surfaces:** Painted, coated, structured or natural.

3. Possible dangers

- **Risk of mechanical injury:** Sharp edges or pointed parts can cause cuts and puncture wounds.
- **Choking hazard:** Small parts can be swallowed by children or pets.
- **Fire hazard:** Flammable materials such as paper, textiles or plastic.
- **Chemical exposure:** Coatings or dyes can be harmful to health if used improperly.

4. Safety instructions

4.1 General safety instructions

- **Keep away from children and pets.**
- **Keep away from open flames and heat sources.**
- **Not for consumption - purely decorative and functional purpose.**
- **Handle sharp or pointed objects carefully.**

4.2 Notes on use

1. Use supplies only for their intended purpose.
2. For materials with coatings or paints, avoid direct skin and mouth contact.
3. Do not reuse damaged or worn items.
4. Securely fasten products to prevent them from tipping over or falling.

4.3 Storage instructions

- Store in a cool, dry place protected from light.
- Protect from moisture and direct sunlight.
- Store sharp or pointed objects safely.

5. First aid measures

- **In case of cuts or puncture wounds:** Clean and disinfect the wound and seek medical attention if necessary.
- **If coatings or dyes come into contact with skin:** Clean thoroughly with soap and water.
- **If swallowed:** Do not give food or drink and seek medical attention immediately.
- **If particles or dust are inhaled:** ensure fresh air supply and seek medical advice if symptoms occur.

6. Firefighting measures

- **Suitable extinguishing agents:** CO₂, foam, powder.
- **Special measures:** Wear respiratory protection when handling flammable materials such as paper or plastic.
- **Note:** Burning may release toxic fumes.

7. Storage and transport

- **Storage:**
 - Store in a dry and safe place.
 - Protect items from mechanical damage.
- **Transport:**
 - Protect from impact and pressure.
 - Pack sharp or delicate items securely.

8. Disposal instructions

- **Material-dependent disposal:**
 - Plastic parts: Recycling according to local regulations.
 - Metal parts: recycling via metal waste.
 - Paper or textiles: waste paper or residual waste according to local regulations.
- Recycle packaging materials according to local regulations.
